Vision Board Message

Recently I ran into a former student's mother. (I haven't seen her since I met with her at school more than ten years ago when her son was in third grade.) I was given the two minute update on her son (now a sophomore in college). ,"Bradley has been trying to contact you...he has something to share," she said before we departed. My curiosity was peaked, so I messaged him on Facebook. I wrote, "Bradley, here's my email address, I heard you are trying to contact me."

The very next day I received a message from him that not only shocked me, but filled my heart with joy. He told me that he wanted to thank me for "saving his life" when he was in elementary school. Apparently, whatever I said/did to him AND his mom impacted him so much that he wanted to find me some 11 years later! His words melted me to my core.

I called his mom and told her about the messages Bradley and I shared. She already knew about them because he called that morning to say, "I found Mrs. Odell (my former last name)!" Bradley's mom then shared that he had written a college entry paper about me when he was in high school. Just 2 hours later, I received a copy of that paper! You can bet I made copies and filed one in my "Smile File."

This experience is a perfect example of what Pastor Mark, in a recent sermon, referred to as "a divine appointment." I also refer to it as "a God Wink." It's the coming together of people who come together, not by coincidence, but rather because it was part of God's plan. You may not have recognized it at the time, but possibly later you are able to see why that person became part of your journey. My husband Ed and I met, not just because our neighbor introduced us, but because God made an appointment for us, knowing we would be happy together. I was put in Bradley's life for a reason that changed his life!

Who is in your life right now, not due to anything you planned, but has impacted your life for the better? Have you thanked them? Have you shared your gratefulness? On the flip side, think hard...has God placed you in someone's life for a reason you may not even be aware of? Have you thanked God for his "divine appointment?"

As summer arrives and you are attending many social events, take time to acknowledge the people who have made your life richer. What's in your head and heart will certainly make another person's heart swell with joy!



Free 2 Be Campaign Update

We are well into the 4th year of our Free2B Grace Capital Campaign. We have been blessed by the generous outpouring of gifts over the last few years. We have painted the building, fixed the roof, replaced the sidewalks, remodeled both of the Golden Rule Daycare bathrooms, and much, much more. Now we are working hard to continue to pay down our mortgage. At the close of April we owed less than \$820,000. It is possible, with your continued Capital and Free2B donations, that we will owe less than \$750,000 at the end of 2017. Praise GOD! We are still working hard to complete our Free2B pledges and promises.

We are grateful for your continued support of our building and grounds. We have made great strides, but we need your continued support as we close the Free2B campaign. We can only meet our current mortgage obligations with help from Free2B donations. If you have questions about your pledge and your contributions to it, please call the church office or log in to GraceLink.

As we near the end of the Free2B Campaign, a team of people are in the early stages of talking about the next steps we will need to take for capital improvements at Grace. They are beginning to make plans for what to do with the portables, fixing the parking lot (which is in terrible shape), and other important improvements, and then, how do we afford to do them. We are excited about this next chapter and how we explore it.
