# Vision Board Minutes

#### November 2018 Vision Board Minutes

The November 2018 Vision Board meeting was held at Grace after a joint meeting with the Transition Team and Call Committee.

The Vision Board approved the Transition Team Final Report, and it was turned over to the Call Committee to start their process.

Pastor Bruce presented his written report. The Call Committee meets 11/17/18 with Pastor John Hulden from the Bishop's office. Pastor Bruce will serve as an on-site resource for the committee but will not be a part of the selection process. Three families attended the Baptism Class. First Communion Class was held on 11/17/18 for the service on 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>. Two households are ready for the next New Member Class. Advent and Christmas services are scheduled. December 22/23 will be "Christmas Early" services.

Our financial statements were reviewed. Grace will balance if we receive \$165,000 in offerings by year end. A year-end push of \$35,000 will be implemented. 66 giving units turned in their Giving Cards. Follow-up will continue on the Giving Cards.

Pastor Bruce, Scott Christensen, Greg Ackerson and Kate Morphew will meet with Jim Dickinson, City of Andover Administrator to clarify what Grace's options are regarding the portables and Nightingale land.

The next meeting of the Vision board is Tuesday, December 11, 2018 at 6:00 pm at Grace Lutheran Church.

We ended the meeting in prayer.

#### **December 2018 Vision Board Minutes**

The December 2018 Vision Board meeting was held at Grace on Tuesday December 11, 2018 from 6:00 pm - 8:33 pm.

The minutes for the November 2018 meeting were approved as submitted.

The Call Committee has begun work on the Ministry Site Profile. Lori Ackerson is Chair of the Committee. John Anderson is their Spiritual Leader and Frances Fernandez will head up Communications. Bishop Ann Svennungsen is scheduled to meet with the congregation on 1/20/19 for face-to-face conversations regarding our wants and needs in a new Senior Pastor.

Scott Christensen, Greg Ackerson, Kate Morphew and Pastor Bruce are working with Jim Dickinson, Andover City Administrator, Julie Trude, Mayor of Andover, and the Andover City Council requesting an extension for the removal of the portables.

Our financial statements were reviewed. No more capital expenditures are expected for this year. Additional Free2B donations will be moved to a dedicated account at year end for future expenses in 2019. A projection of \$80,000.00 in donations to our "Current Fund" are still needed to balance this year's budget. Benevolence for the Synod is complete for 2018. The 2019 budget will be presented to the congregation on 1/22/19 for review. The Annual Meeting follows all services on 1-26/27-19.

The next meeting of the Vision Board is Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at 6:00 pm at Grace Lutheran Church.



# Message from Pastor Bruce

### A New Year, a New Chapter

In the Word was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. (John 1:4-5)

The first Sunday of 2019 is January 6, the Day of Epiphany when we remember the journey of the magi to visit the Christ Child. As the story is told in Matthew 2, these "magi from the East" would probably have been from ancient Persia or modernday Iran. Iran's capitol, Tehran, is about 1250 miles from Bethlehem. That would have been a long and slow journey on camelback. It may have involved a huge caravan of magi, families, servants, livestock, and camels. They may have camped along the journey for extended periods of time, living in large tents like modern-day Bedouins. The trip could have taken two years. As the saying goes, the journey of a thousand miles begins with one step. Guided by the light of a star, magi and caravan set out on their journey. And camel step by camel step, they eventually reached the Holy Family and knelt before the Christ Child.

We begin the journey of a new year by taking one step. We know little to nothing of what lies ahead. In our lives and in our world, there will be joys and

sorrows. There will be struggles and pleasant surprises. But we will journey forward, one step and one day at a time. As we journey, we are guided by One who travels with us. Jesus the Christ, born as light of the world, travels with us through whatever we will face in the year ahead. I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life. (John 8:12) Present with us in community, even where only two or three are gathered, this is the One we follow into a new year and new chapter.

A new year means continuing to move into a new chapter for Grace. As of mid-December, the Call Committee has met three times. They were installed during worship services on December 15/16. They are completing the Ministry Site Profile and will submit it by mid-January.

Bishop Ann Svennungsen will worship with Grace on Sunday morning, January 20. At 11:30 that morning, all are invited into the worship center for conversation with her about your hopes and dreams for Grace's future and your new pastor.

The Call Committee will receive candidate names about a month later in February. This means they'll likely be ready to begin interviews during the first part of March. This is good timing since it could allow Call Committee members to hear candidates preach and potentially conduct second interviews before Holy Week and Easter in mid-April. (Again, the goal is to have the new pastor on board next summer before Rally weekend.)

Grace will begin a new chapter in this New Year as you call a new pastor. Together you will journey, step by step, as you follow the One born as light of the world. Please continue praying for the Call Committee. And may God bless the remainder of our travels together in 2019!
