#### "God goes to the dogs?"

Being on vacation usually affords one the opportunity to read for enjoyment. While on vacation recently, I did just that. Often I will ask my wife for a book recommendation, as she is an avid reader. She recommended the book "Rescuing Finley" by Dan Walsh. One of the characters in the book is a young woman, Amy, who is in prison for robbery. Because of good behavior, Amy is nominated to be part of a prison program where she works with the dog, Finley. Finley then becomes a support dog for a war veteran. Amy professes her faith in Finley,

"It was like God knew I needed him, at just the right moment. I know this part'll sound kind of crazy. But I think God made dogs different than other animals and gave them a special gift. Some days, I swear I feel God's love coming right through Finley, straight into my heart. For the first time in my life—just being around him—I think I understand what unconditional love and acceptance feels like, or something very close to it. Finley likes me regardless of my problems. He gives his love away for free, every day, without judgment, without prejudice or a moment's hesitation. One look in his eyes and you can tell, he doesn't care about anything you've done, or any of the stupid mistakes you've made. Whatever's wrong with you, even whatever you think is wrong with you, Finley doesn't care."

This is so true about God and dogs. We are so lucky to have a God that is so forgiving and accepting of us no matter who we are. We in turn should live a life of acceptance and forgiveness towards others in a dog sort of way.

After reading this book I definitely see my own dog in a different light and I am thankful for a God that sees me as I am.

#### Vacation Bible School

The decision regarding VBS this summer was entrusted to the Children's Ministry Team (CMT). - 2. There are at least five veteran volunteer leaders who traditionally invest many hours in VBS who are unavailable this summer.

The CMT decided it would be better to take this summer off and bring VBS back in 2020, rather than risk running a program that might encounter difficulties and discourage some families and Grace volunteers from returning in 2020. The Vision Board fully understands and supports this decision. While we will miss VBS this summer, we look forward to the return of VBS next summer!


